Child Care Aware® staff will provide the eligibility forms and connect the family with their local partner agency. The partner agency will assist families to find a respite care provider to meet their child's needs.

How Do I Know If I Am Eligible?

- ▶ The exceptional family member (EFM) is enrolled in the EFMP
- ▶ The EFM child is age birth through 18
- ▶ The EFM child is diagnosed with severe or moderate special needs
- ▶ Eligible EFM child's siblings are age birth through 12
- ▶ The Airman is active duty, including activated Air Guard and Reserve, if activated for at
