Base Housing Office

Located in building 119. You may apply for on-base housing by advance application through your family housing management office. Waiting periods vary according to grade of applicant and size of family (see the Grand Forks AFB Waiting List at the Guest Reception). 547 units are located on the main base. Service can be on either a walk-in or appointment basis during normal duty hours.



You must check-in to your squadron prior to coming to housing. You may also complete an advance housing application for your next duty station if you desire base housing or want assistance in locating housing in the local community. Contacting the Housing Office early contributes to making your moving plans go as smooth as possible and helps with timely notification of the next person on the waiting list. - Active Duty personnel of the US Armed Forces. Reserve personnel are not authorized care unless on active duty. When on active duty they receive the same care as all other active duty personnel. Appointments can only be made with active duty orders in hand.
- Family members of Active Duty on a stand-by space available basis only.
- Retired personnel on a stand-by space available basis only. Family members of retired on a stand-by basis only.
- Emergency dental services to relieve severe discomfort, severe bleeding, or acute infection is available for all eligible beneficiaries.
- Dental sick call is held daily by appointment.
- Family members of active duty personnel are highly encouraged to enroll in the TRICARE Family Member Dental Plan to obtain dental care from civilian dentists. Retired personnel are highly encouraged to enroll the TRICARE Retiree Dental Program to obtain dental care from civilian dentists.

Road Tests: By appointment only.

Written Tests: No appointment needed. Arrive no later than one hour prior to noon and no later than one hour prior to closing.

To obtain a North Dakota operator's license, you must visit one of the Drivers License and Testing offices. No appointment is needed to take the written examination; however, you must have an appointment for a road test.

Please notify the Drivers License and Traffic Safety Division if you change your address. Commercial license holders must obtain a duplicate license if there is a change of address. You may renew your drivers license 10 months prior to its expiration date without losing any of the time remaining on your current license. You must retest if your license is expired more than one year.





Age Requirements

The minimum driving age in North Dakota is 16. You may not drive in North Dakota if you are under 16, even if you are licensed in another state. However, a North Dakota resident can obtain a restricted license at the age of 14. A parent or legal guardian must sign for a minor under the age of 18 to be issued a permit or license. If you are at least 14 years of age and wish to be identified as a donor on your operator's license, permit, or identification card, you may do so by signing the donor identification block on the application form.



Identification Requirements

As part of a nationwide effort to enhance the issuance of secure identification credentials, proof of current name and date of birth is required when applying for a North Dakota Permit, License, or Identification card. Out of state permits, licenses, and ID cards will not be accepted as proof of name and date of birth.

Acceptable Forms of Identification are:

1. U.S. Birth Certificate (state certified; Government-issued; includes U.S. territories).
2. Valid U.S. Passport
3. U.S. Government-issued Consular Report of Birth Abroad (Certificate or FS240-seal required).
4. Valid Foreign Passport with an I-94 card or an I-551 stamp.
5. U.S. Active Duty/Retiree/Reservist Military ID Card.
6. U.S. Court Order containing the legal name and date of birth (Court seal required). Divorce decree and marriage certificate are not acceptable for proof of date of birth.
7. North Dakota state issued permit, license, or ID card
8. The following Immigration documents (unexpired):
 - I-551 Resident Alien or Permanent Resident Card
 - I-688 Temporary Resident Identification Card
 - I-688B, I-766 Employment Authorization Card
 - N560 Certificate of Citizenship
 - N550 Certificate of Naturalization
 - I-94 card stamped Refugee or Asylee

Only original documents and certified copies will be accepted. No photocopies. A court order or government issued marriage certificate is required for a name change. Several documents may be necessary in the event there has been more than one name change since birth.
